

Donald Wayne Holdman (1950–2025)

Don was a classically trained fine artist whose work reflected a lifelong commitment to craft, clarity, and quiet observation. Educated at the University of Colorado, Trinidad State Junior College, and the Colorado Institute of Art, he built a career spanning painting, design, and creative direction, including creating the first official artwork for the Martin Luther King Jr. Federal Holiday celebration. After retiring in 2010, Holdman devoted himself fully to studio practice, exhibiting throughout Colorado and Georgia and earning recognition for his thoughtful use of negative space and restraint. Homeward Bound, presented alongside works by Susan Easton-Burns and PeQue, honors his enduring legacy and the reflective spirit that guided his work.
